We aim to grow our UK market coverage further through additional products and services including clinician facing platforms and cutting-edge AI-driven predictive analytics tools. MWDH also supports the UoD national MyDiabetesMyWay service in Scotland. Internationally, we have set up an office in Dubai and managing commercials opportunities in the Middle-East (particularly Saudi Arabia) and Asia.
